<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GLOUCESTERSHIRE WAY - 100 miles.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">8 sections of between 11-14 miles.</p> <p>The walk starts from Chepstow Castle in Wales to finishes at Tewkesbury in Gloucestershire. We visit the Forest of Dean, May Hill, Gloucester, the Severn Plain and the Cotswolds villages of Stow on the Wold and Winchcombe.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>HEART OF ENGLAND WAY - 101 miles</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">8 sections of between 10-13 miles with one short section of 8 miles and one long section of 15 miles</p> <p>Walk through the Midlands of England, the walk starts from Milford Common on Cannock Chase and finishes at Bourton on the Water in the Cotswolds. We pass through the counties of Staffordshire, Warwickshire and Gloucestershire visiting Bourton on the Water, Chipping Campden, Bidford on Avon, Henley in Arden, Kingsbury Water Park and Lichfield</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>THREE CHOIRS WAY - 100 miles</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">10 sections of between 9-11 miles</p> <p>A route between Gloucester, Hereford and Worcester through the countryside of hop-yards, vineyards and orchards with a theme linking the walk to the ancient music festival still celebrated annually in the three cathedrals.</p> <p>The rivers Severn, Wye, Teme and Lugg are crossed as are the Marcle, Malvern Ridges and Suckley Hills.</p>
